Salient Points

- National Institute Of Technology, Tiruchirappalli, offers B.Sc. B.Ed (Secondary Stage) from the academic session 2024-25.
- It is a 4-year integrated Dual Major programme, with one major in Education and the other in any of the following three disciplines: **Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics**
- A student will be allotted any one of the above Disciplinary Majors based on his/her score in the National Common Entrance Test (NCET).
- The students who have passed class XII in Science Stream having **Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics** as the combination of subjects are eligible to apply for any of the above disciplinary Majors.
- They must have appeared for the test in **Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics** as the domain subjects in the NCET conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).
- Candidates must have secured at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent grades in class XII.
- Admission to the programme will be based on the NCET total score secured by the candidates in all seven subjects (e.g., Languages 1 and 2, Teaching Aptitude, General Test, and three relevant Domain-specific Subjects) covering four different sections.
- If a candidate is absent in the NCET Test of any of the seven subjects, that candidate will not be considered for admission.
- The admission counseling for the B.Sc. B.Ed. programme of NIT Trichy will be conducted by NIT Trichy.
- The students are required to give their choices for the Dual Major programme, clearly mentioning in order of preferences for the Disciplinary Majors (Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics).
- Applications are to be submitted through <https://nittcuetsamarth.edu.in/ncet/>
- Candidates seeking admission have to pay a non-refundable fee of ₹ 500/- per discipline.
- Candidates who have submitted the Application Form can modify their disciplinary Major choices until the last date of application submission.
- Candidates should regularly check the allocation of seats and exercise their decision through the Application Portal.
- Candidates who are offered seats should pay a Seat Acceptance Fee ONLINE within the stipulated time.
- The total number of seats available at NIT Trichy is 50, distributed across four disciplinary majors. Details of the seat matrix are given in Table 1.

About NIT Trichy

The National Institute of Technology (formerly Regional Engineering College) Tiruchirappalli was established as a joint venture of the Government of India and the Government of Tamil Nadu in 1964 to produce world-class engineers who will cater to the growing technological needs of the nation. The institute was granted Deemed University status with the approval of the UGC / AICTE and Government of India in 2003 and renamed as National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli (NIT-T). NIT-T has been declared as Institution of National Importance by National Institute of Technology act 2007.

National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli has carved a mark on the National scene being ranked first among all the NITs and 9th among all the technical institutes in the country by the Institute Ranking framework (NIRF) of the Government of India. The institution offers Under Graduate Courses in ten branches and Post Graduate Courses in thirty-one disciplines of Science, Engineering & Technology besides M.S. (by Research) and Ph.D. in all the departments. The institute is an example of cultural unity with students drawn from most of the states in the country. The hallmark of the campus is the good facilities which caters to the academic and extracurricular interests of the students. The Octagon is the pride of the campus equipped with modern facilities like a CAD/CAM Lab, Local Area Network, High-Speed Internet connection, and other seminar and conference facilities. It is maintained and run by the Computer Support Group (CSG) of the institute.

The National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli, is committed to transforming into a more holistic and multidisciplinary education, adapting the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP2020). To ensure outstanding students enter into the teaching profession, NEP2020 stipulates, "Recognizing that the teachers will require training in high-quality content as well as pedagogy, teacher education will gradually be moved by 2030 into multidisciplinary colleges and universities" [Para 5.22, NEP 2020]."

The National Education Policy 2020 highlights, "The 4-year integrated B.Ed. will be a dual-major holistic bachelor's degree in education as well as a specialized subject such as language, history, music, mathematics, computer science, chemistry, economics, art, physical education, etc. Beyond the teaching of cutting-edge pedagogy, the teacher education will include grounding in sociology, history, science, psychology, early childhood care and education, foundational literacy and numeracy, knowledge of India and its values/ethos/art/traditions, and more". [Para 15.5, NEP 2020]

With time, NIT Trichy has expanded its ambit from offering Engineering to Sciences, Management, Economics, Entrepreneurship, and Humanities. The Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) is a new addition to its ever-expanding vision of inclusive professional and need-based education. With close to 12000 students across UG, PG and PhD programmes, NIT Trichy is one of the most diversified institutions in the country. About the Programme

A first of its kind in the NIT system, NIT Trichy with the objective to offer the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) a 4-year integrated programme under which the students will have a Dual Major undergraduate degree in a specific discipline along with B.Ed. Keeping in view the mandate of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and subsequent initiatives by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) (Ministry of Education, Government of India, New Delhi), NIT Trichy offers **B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary Stage)** with Majors in four different disciplines, namely, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Economics. Apart from preparing teachers for the reconfigured school education system in the country, the ITEP will help impart disciplinary knowledge in the abovementioned subjects so that the students will gain in-depth knowledge. It would also ensure their admission to higher studies in the disciplinary streams, including higher professional education.

The ITEP at NIT Trichy is of 4-year duration across eight semesters of study. It is a Dual-Major Bachelor's Degree programme, with one Major in Education and the other in any of the following

Three disciplines: Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics. In addition, it intends to develop among student-teachers ethics of social engagement, and capacities such as problem- solving, critical and creative thinking, communication skills, ethical and moral reasoning, etc.

The students joining this programme shall specialize in the secondary stage of school education, which will qualify them to become teachers at that stage. [The curriculum and detailed syllabi can be accessed by visiting www.nitt.edu](http://www.nitt.edu) .

The B.Sc. B.Ed. programme is credit-based and thus offers the flexibility to progress at one's own pace. A minimum level of performance is essential for satisfactory progress.

Admission to the Programme

Admission to the programme will be made through the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA). The results of the NCET will be used for admission. The seat matrix of the Three Disciplinary Majors under B.Sc. B.Ed. programme of NIT Trichy is given in Table 1.

Eligibility Requirement (ER) and Minimum Educational Qualification (MEQ)

Candidates who have appeared NCET and have secured a valid score are eligible to apply for B.Sc. B.Ed. 2024 admission at NIT Trichy, provided they satisfy the following:

- The candidates must have passed the class XII Examinations in Science Stream with **Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics** in the combination of subjects.
- They must have appeared for the test in **Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics** as the domain subjects in the NCET conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).
- Candidates must have secured at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent grades in class XII.
- Proof of having passed Class XII and having secured requisite marks must be submitted at the time of submitting the application. Original documents must be furnished to NIT Trichy at the time of admission.
- Foreign nationals with Indian education are eligible to apply, subject to the policy of the Institute.
- A candidate should have appeared in the Class XII (or equivalent) examination for the first time in either 2022, 2023 or 2024, with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics as compulsory subjects.
- Candidates should have been born on or after October 1, 1999. Five years of age relaxation is given to SC, ST, and PwD candidates, i.e., these candidates should have been born on or after October 1, 1994.

For candidates satisfying the ERs, MEQs and other necessary requirements, based on their NCET score, seats will be allotted without any additional interview or written test. At the time of admission, all admitted candidates may have to submit a Physical Fitness certificate from a registered medical practitioner in the prescribed form to NIT Trichy. The admitted candidates may also have to undergo a Physical Fitness test by a medical board constituted by the Institute. In case candidates are not found physically fit to pursue their chosen programme of study, their admission is liable to be cancelled.

If a Board awards only letter grades without providing an equivalent percentage of marks on the grade sheet, the candidate should obtain a certificate from the Board specifying the equivalent marks and submit it at the time of acceptance of the allocated seat. In case, such a certificate is not provided, the decision taken by NIT Trichy will be final.

Reservation of Seats

Indian nationals belonging to different categories are admitted under the seats reserved for them in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government of India.

Under each Disciplinary Major, a certain number of seats, as listed in Table 1, is reserved for candidates belonging to various categories. Candidates who seek admission under the SC or ST category must submit the requisite certificates issued by a competent authority as specified in Annexure 2. Candidates who seek admission under the OBC-NCL or EWS Category must submit an OBC-NCL or EWS Certificate issued by a competent authority as specified in Annexure 2, in a format similar to that shown in Annexure 3 for OBC-NCL and Annexure 4 for EWS. Valid

certificates for OBC-NCL or EWS issued on or after April 1, 2024, should be submitted for application processing. However, candidates securing seats under the OBC-NCL or EWS category may be required to show a valid certificate to NIT Trichy at the time of joining.

Candidates who seek admission under the PwD category must submit a disability certificate (refer to Annexure 2) or a Unique Disability Identification (UDID) certificate. Benefits of reservations would be given only to those who have benchmark disability, i.e., not less than 40% impairment, irrespective of the type of disability. Such candidates must submit, along with the filled-in Application Form, the Certificate of Disability from a Government Medical Board and should be fit to pursue the Programme. The certificate should preferably be in the format given in Form 1 or Form 2, or Form 3 (as applicable) in the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017. The disability percentage of candidates selected for admission in the PwD category may also be required to be certified by a Medical Board, duly constituted by the Admitting Institute. Candidates must note that the benefits of reservation will be given to them subject to verification of documents. If it is discovered at any stage that a candidate has used a false/fake/incorrect document or has furnished false, incorrect, or incomplete information, in order to avail of the benefits of reservation, then such a candidate shall be excluded from the admission process. In case such a candidate has already been given admission, the admission shall stand cancelled.

Application Procedure

Applications for Admissions to B.Sc. B.Ed. programme at NIT Trichy must be submitted online at [NITT Samarth Portal](#) by paying a non-refundable application fee of ₹500/-. Only candidates of the NCET 2024 Result List will be eligible to apply for admission. Only one duly completed Application Form should be submitted per discipline. The candidates are requested to verify the details on the candidate portal [NITT Samarth Portal](#) before the start of the admission process and contact NIT Trichy via email (admissions@nitt.edu for technical issues, itep@nitt.edu for any general queries), in case of any discrepancy. The list of documents required for applying is given in Annexure 5. Based on the required Test Paper(s) (Domain-specific) qualified, a candidate can apply to **one or more Discipline/Majors** under B.Sc. B.Ed. programme covered under that Test Paper(s), subject to the fulfilment of the MEQs and ERs of NIT Trichy. All Disciplinary Majors to which the candidate is seeking admission must apply individually with registration fee.

Admission Procedure

An Applicant will be considered for admission to the Disciplinary Major according to choices filled in the Application Form. There will be three rounds of counseling, in the normal case. If seats remain vacant, additional rounds may be conducted. Applicants receiving an offer in any of the rounds are required to login at [NITT Samarth Portal](#) within the stipulated time.

When an applicant chooses the decision for the first time, the Applicant will be directed to an online payment portal to pay the Seat Acceptance Fee of ₹10,000/- for General/OBC-NCL/EWS category and ₹5,000/- for SC/ST/PwD category within the stipulated time.

- Based on the order of preferences given by the candidates in the Application Form and the corresponding score in the Merit List, the First Admission List will be prepared on or before a date (*to be announced later*). The candidates are required to login to the portal to view their status.

- Applicants who are offered seats in the First Round must login to the Candidate Portal and pay the Seat Acceptance Fee by a date (*to be announced later*).
- If seats remain vacant after the first round of admission, a Second Admission List will be prepared on or before a date (*to be announced later*). The candidates are required to login to the portal to view their current seat allocation.
- Applicants who are offered seats in the Second List must login to the Candidate Portal and pay the Seat Acceptance Fee by a date (*to be announced later*).
- If seats remain vacant after the second round of admission, a Third Admission List will be prepared by a date (*to be announced later*). The candidates are required to login to the portal to view their current seat allocation.
- Applicants who are offered seats in the Third List must login to the Candidate Portal and pay the Seat Acceptance Fee by a date above by a date (*to be announced later*).
- The Applicants who are offered seats can CANCEL the offer by logging into Candidate Portal and choosing "Withdraw". This option would be available till the end of the second round of counseling. The Seat Acceptance Fee would be refunded after deducting a Processing Fee of ₹1,000/-.
- Offer letters from NIT Trichy will be available for download by the candidates through the Candidate Portal after the final round of admissions. The applicants who are offered a seat should report to NIT Trichy along with the required documents, as per their offer letter.

Important Points to Note:

1. Applicants are requested to periodically check the NIT Trichy website [NITT Samarth Portal](#) for updates and the Candidate Portal for the status of their applications. They should also check the messages sent to their registered e-mail ID.
2. Incomplete applications or applications that are not supported by valid documents will be rejected. The application fee, if paid, would not be refunded for applications that are rejected. The Application Form for admission will not be considered if the fee is not received by NIT Trichy before the application deadline. No intimation regarding the rejection of the application form will be sent to the candidates.
3. Applicants who are not allotted seats in a round may get seats allotted in the subsequent rounds. Applicants who fail to accept seats offered at any stage will not be considered further in the admission process.
4. Last date for the payment of the fees for the seats allotted in each round cannot be relaxed in any case. If the candidate does not accept the seat offered or payment is not made within the stipulated period, the offer gets automatically cancelled. No other requests or correspondence on this matter will be entertained.
5. Candidates should note that being on the NCET Result List neither guarantees nor provides any automatic entitlement for admission. Admissions shall be made in order of merit and depending on the number of seats available at NIT Trichy.
6. The offer of admission to a candidate made during the seat allocation process would remain provisional, subject to the fulfillment of all the requirements stipulated by NIT Trichy as per the fixed deadlines.
7. With regard to the interpretation of the provisions on any matter not covered in this Information Brochure, the decision of NIT Trichy shall be final and binding on all the parties concerned.
8. NTA has the overall responsibility of conducting NCET 2024. In case of any claims or disputes related to NCET 2024, the NTA may be consulted.
