

## **INFORMATION BROCHURE (MBA ADMISSION 2025)**

## National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli

The National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli, established in 1964, is a prestigious institution dedicated to higher education and advanced research. Recognized as an Institute of National Importance, it consistently holds the top rank among all NITs in the NIRF rankings. The institute is renowned for its state-of-the-art infrastructure, which supports both academic excellence and diverse extracurricular activities.

#### **Department of Management Studies:**

The Department of Management Studies (DoMS), National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli, established in 1978, is a distinguished business school with a legacy spanning 46 years. Consistently ranked first among NIT B-Schools in the NIRF rankings, DoMS invites applications for its full-time, two-year flagship MBA program for the 2025-2027 academic session, marking the 47<sup>th</sup> MBA batch of the department.

#### **Eligibility:**

- As per institute norms, candidates must have a full-time, regular undergraduate degree in any discipline with a minimum of 60% marks or a 6.5 CGPA for GENERAL, EWS, and OBC-NCL candidates, and 55% marks or a 6.0 CGPA for SC/ST/PwD candidates.
- Candidates must have a CAT 2024 percentile in the Common Admission Test (CAT) 2024.
- Candidates currently in the final year of their undergraduate program and who have CAT 2024 percentile are also eligible to apply, provided they meet the criteria specified above upon completion of their undergraduate degree.

## **Selection parameters:**

Candidates will be shortlisted based on their CAT 2024 overall percentile scores, and shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend an online interview. The final selection criteria include the CAT 2024 overall percentile score, performance in the online personal interview, academic achievements, and professional work experience.

**Application Fees:** The application fees will be Rs.1550/- for GEN/OBC-NCL/GEN-EWS and Rs.1050/- for SC/ST/ PwD candidates.

#### **Important Dates:**

- Start date of Online application: 24<sup>th</sup> January 2025.
- o Last date for submission of the Online application: 28th February 2025, 06:00 PM.

#### Other important points:

- 1. Candidates with a previous year's CAT percentile are not eligible to apply.
- 2. Conversion between CGPA and percentage is not allowed. If both CGPA and percentage are provided in a mark sheet, only the CGPA will be considered.
- 3. The online application fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.
- 4. Candidates applying under OBC-NCL and GEN-EWS categories must submit certificates dated between April 2024 and March 2025. Failure to provide the required certificate will result in consideration under the GENERAL category for shortlisting and further processing.
- State-issued Backward Community (BC) or Most Backward Community (MBC) certificates are not valid for OBC-NCL. Candidates submitting state-issued BC/MBC certificates under the OBC-NCL category will be considered under the GENERAL

- category for shortlisting and further processing.
- 6. The institute will not be responsible for incorrect entries or technical errors while filling out the online application or making fee payments.
- 7. The online application submitted by the applicant is final and binding.
- 8. Requests for corrections to the online application will not be entertained.
- 9. Candidates must apply only through the online portal and carefully review their application details before submitting it.
- 10. An application number will be auto-generated upon final submission in the portal.
- 11. Submission of a hard copy of the application is not required.
- 12. Admission will be provisional, subject to verification of eligibility criteria, including original qualifying degree certificates and other documents.
- 13. Selected candidates pursuing their final year of undergraduate studies will be admitted provisionally, provided they meet all requirements for the qualifying degree, including the minimum percentage/CGPA, at the time of admission.
- 14. All original documents will be verified during physical reporting for admission. Any discrepancies will result in the cancellation of admission.
- 15. Applicant details, such as age and work experience, will be considered as of the last date of final submission in the online portal.
- 16. Candidates are advised to regularly check the MBA Admissions pages on the NIT, Tiruchirapalli Trichy website for updates.
- 17. The list of shortlisted candidates for online personal interviews will be displayed on the NIT, Tiruchirappalli website and MBA admission portal.

- 19. Provisionally selected candidates under OBC-NCL and GEN-EWS categories must submit their latest certificates (issued after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025) during physical reporting for admission.

## Steps to apply:

- Verify eligibility criteria and the year of CAT appearance.
- Complete the application fee payment through Samarth e-Gov Portal.
- Prepare scanned copies of the following documents in PDF format for uploading to the admission portal:
  - Aadhaar card
  - o CAT 2024 Score Card
  - o 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Mark Sheets
  - Undergraduate mark sheets or consolidated grade sheets
  - Degree or provisional certificate (if available)
  - Transfer certificate (if available)
  - Category certificate (SC/ST)
  - Non-Creamy Layer certificate (for OBC-NCL)
  - Economically Weaker Section certificate (for EWS)
  - Professional work experience certificate (if applicable)
  - Scanned image of the applicant's passport-size photograph
  - Scanned image of the applicant's signature
- Candidates awaiting final exam results must upload the latest semester mark sheet along with all previous semester mark sheets as a single PDF.
- Category certificates such as OBC-NCL or EWS must be obtained on or after 1st April 2024.
- For OBC-NCL, GEN-EWS, and PwD categories, an affidavit may be uploaded if the applicant has applied for the certificate but has not yet received it.
