Engagement of Visiting Consultants

Applications are invited from Indian nationals for the engagement of visiting consultants on a purely contract basis at the NITT Hospital, National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli. The initial tenure of the contract appointment is six months only. The tenure of the appointment may be extended subject to the satisfactory performance of the candidate and the necessity for continued retention. The applications may be filled out through the portal <https://nittnt.samarth.edu.in/index.php/site/login>, which is mentioned on the Institute website www.nitt.edu. The position will be engaged through an outsourcing agency.

Remuneration:

The Honorarium payable to the Visiting consultant would be fixed at Rs. 2,500/- per visit (Timings: Dermatologist:3 hours/ day, ENT 2 hours/ day, Psychiatry 2 hours/ day). In addition, the Visiting Consultant is eligible for the Conveyance Charges of Rs. 500/- per visit.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The engagement of Visiting consultants will be purely temporary and will not confer any right to them to claim the status of a regular employee of the institute.
2. The Visiting Consultant will not be entitled to any other Allowance or Benefits other than those indicated above.
3. The Visiting Consultants will abide by the Institute's Rules and Regulations governing their engagement.
4. The Visiting Consultants will safeguard the security and confidentiality of all official matters and secrecy of information coming to their knowledge.
5. The Honorarium is fixed, and there is no scope for an increased Honorarium.

Termination of Engagement:

The Engagement of the Visiting Consultant will stand automatically terminated on completion of the prescribed tenure as specified in the Offer of Engagement. The Engagement can be terminated even earlier, with a 01-month Notice in writing either side.

Selection Criteria: Certificate Verification and Interview

General Instructions:

1. The applicants should go through all the instructions carefully and ensure that they fulfil all eligibility conditions. Their admission to all stages of the recruitment will be purely provisional, subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions.
2. Candidates should carefully fill up all the details required in the application form, including age, Educational Qualification, details of valid Community/PwD Certificates, etc., as no correspondence regarding the change of details will be entertained after the last date for applying. If any of the claims made by the candidate are found to be incorrect, it will lead to the rejection of the candidature.
3. The prescribed essential qualifications/experience indicated are bare minimum, and mere possession of the same will not entitle the candidate to be called for Certificate Verification / Interview.
4. Any experience gained after the minimum qualifying degree will only be considered.
5. The Institute reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates called for the selection process to a reasonable limit based on qualifications, level of relevance of experience higher than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement and other academic achievements. The Institute has the right to decide the mode of screening and test the applicant for shortlisting and selection.
6. The number of vacancies indicated in the notification is tentative. The Institute reserves the right not to fill any or all posts advertised and to reject any or all applications without assigning any reason.
