3. Eligible Degrees for Consideration:

4. <u>Instructions for Applicants:</u>

- Applicants are required to submit online application and the candidates applying for more than one post are required to submit application for each discipline separately. Enclosures, if any, in support of application are to be uploaded as separate documents (pdf preferred) along with the application form.
- Candidate should pay a non-refundable application processing fee per department applied through online payment as below:
 - For the candidates other than SC/ST/PWD/Women Category: Rs. 1,000 (Rupees One thousand only) per department
 - For SC/ ST Category: Rs.500 (Rupees Five hundred only) per department
 - For Woman Candidates & PWD Category: No fee is required.
 - Application processing fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
 - Indian Nationals applying from abroad can pay their application fee in US \$25 per post (for all categories) online through the application portal. Online application submitted without requisite fee will be rejected without any correspondence.
- A detailed Academic Profile, inter alia, including the following information is required to be submitted:
- a) Teaching Plan: Candidates are required to give the following as part of Teaching Plan. i) List of core courses that they can teach at the UG and PG level. ii) An expanded statement of teaching objectives and long-term interests in coursework development. iii) For those with prior teaching experience, the student feedback ratings and profiles of at least two best courses taught by the

- candidate. iv) Details of any academic awards and participation in faculty development programs as a participant or as a resource person.
- b) Research Plan: Expanded statement of the research plan is to include the following:
 - i) Highlighting the current and past research interests of the candidate including any significant achievements ii) Future research plans in the short and long terms
- c) Details of Journal publications: (SCI/Scopus)
 - Candidates are expected to upload a list of journal publications along with copies of 4 best papers authored by them in the last 5 years chronologically listing:
 - Names of authors, Title of the paper, Name of the Journal/Conference Publications, Volume/Proceedings, pages (from to), Year, etc. The same shall be grouped as Journal Publications and papers presented at National / International Conferences.
- d) Details of Awards, Patents, Prizes etc., indicating: Nature, Name of prize/award, awarded by, awarded for, year of award; Name of the patent, year and details about the patent, etc. as well as the candidate's specific contribution vis-a-vis the Co-inventors.
- e) Research Guidance (only Ph.D. with formal Guide Status):
 - Research degree, Name of the scholar, Title of the Thesis, Year of award etc. (on-going supervision may also be indicated separately).
- f) Details of Externally funded / Sponsored projects:
 - Title of the project, Duration, Sponsor, Value, Co–investigators, if any, role of the candidate and specific contributions, etc. Candidates should highlight specific contributions, if any, to industry/pointing out the challenges overcome and the value added etc.
- g) Industrial Experience and Consultancy: Details of industrial experience and relevance to proposed teaching and research.
- h) Other Activities Like:
 - Lab Experiments added, outreach activity, E-learning/ICT based methodology adopted for teaching, Text books and Monographs if any authorized by the candidate along with details, continuing education programs / conferences organized (as an organizer or co-organizer) etc.
- i) Any other relevant but brief information on academic standing.

Further, only in case of shortlisted candidates, References will be invited directly from the referees by the Institute.

5. Additional Information:

- a) Separate online application must be submitted for each cadre/grade along with prescribed fee.
- b) The cut-off date for determining eligibility of candidates is the closing date for receipt of application forms.
- c) Reservation will be as per Govt. of India norms prevalent at the time of interview.
- d) Mere fulfilment of minimum qualifications and experience does not entitle any candidate to receive call letter for selection.
- e) To limit applicants to a reasonable number, the Institute has the right to set higher norms for scrutiny than minimum prescribed above. The areas of specialization and the post/level applied for will be taken into account while shortlisting, giving due consideration to the specific requirements of the individual Departments. Hence different Departments may have different shortlisting criteria which may vary for different posts within the same Department. MHRD guidelines received from time to time for this purpose will be followed. The decision of the Institute related to all matters pertaining to the recruitment shall be final and binding on the applicants.

- f) Selection will be done in two phases. In the first phase, the shortlisted candidates are required to appear for a written test/give a seminar in the area of their specialization in the respective department. The seminar is open to faculty of the department. The second phase involves interview by the Selection Committee.
- g) The list of shortlisted candidates for selection process (seminar presentation and interview) will be displayed on the website of the Institute. Candidates are advised to visit the website **www.iiitt.ac.in** regularly. No separate call letter will be sent. Email communication will only be sent.
- h) Higher starting pay may be offered to deserving candidates on the recommendation of the Selection Committee at the discretion of the Board of Governors.
- i) Candidates serving in Government/Semi-Government/PSUs / Universities /Educational Institutions should send their applications either THROUGH PROPER CHANNEL or should furnish a NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE from the competent authority at the time of interview. They can, however, send advance copy of completed application form.
- i) No TA/DA will be paid for attending test/seminar/interview.
- k) The number of vacancies mentioned is indicative only. The Institute reserves the right to fill or not to fill any of the vacancies.
- Reservation policy will be as per Government of India norms. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS/PWD should enclose a copy of the certificate issued by the competent authority along with the online application; candidates belonging to OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) should enclose photocopy of the OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) certificate issued by competent authority on or after 01/04/2019; otherwise their application will be considered in unreserved (UR) category only.
- m) The persons with disability (PWD) with 40% and above shall be required to produce medical certificate in the prescribed form issued by the competent medical authorities for the purpose of employment.
- n) More than six months of experience in relevant regular position in any organization will only be considered for total experience.
- o) Original documents and ID proof (Aadhaar/Passport/Voter ID/PAN Card) will have to be produced at the time of interview, else the candidate will not be allowed to attend the interview.
- p) Selection Committee may offer lower faculty position, than the post applied for in case of application for Pay Level-12 and above. The Institute reserves the right to modify / defer or cancel the advertisement/ recruitment at any stage of processing without assigning any reasons.
- q) A dispute with regard to selection process will be subjected to contribution having jurisdiction over **Tiruchirappalli** only.
- r) The candidate is responsible for the correctness of the information provided in the application. If it is found, at a later date, that any information given in the application is incorrect/false, the candidate is liable for criminal action.
- s) No correspondence will be entertained with the candidates, who are not called for selection process.
- t) Candidates working as Engineers/Scientists in Research or Industrial organizations meeting all the eligibility conditions can also apply through proper channel. They need to provide the proof of their credentials certified through a competent authority.
- u) Candidates should apply only through online.
- v) Canvassing in any form will result in disqualification of candidature.

The selection process consists of two phases

- a) Seminar Presentation
- b) Interview

The shortlisted candidates will be invited to give seminar presentation before the duly constituted committee. Only the candidates recommended by the committee based on their performance in the seminar presentation shall attend interview before the selection panel.


