

- Graduates holding Second Class and above in B.Lib & I.Sc. from any recognized University may apply. Knowledge of Computer data processing is desirable. Preference will be given to candidates who have some previous experience of working in a Technical Library.
- Maximum age limit is 28 years for general category candidates, 31 years for OBC category candidates and 33 years for SC/ST category candidates as on 23.11.2011.
- Training will be imparted on batch system between 8.30 hours and 22.00 hours.
- The selected candidates are eligible for a monthly stipend of Rs. 8000- and Rs.8500- per month (consolidated) during the I year and II year respectively.
- They should be prepared to do the physical work of shifting of books and maintenance of book stacks etc.
- The selected candidates will have to execute a bond on a Rs.25/- non-judicial stamp paper towards the fulfillment of the Training Programme.
