- 1. Service tax will be extra if applicable for this contract.
- 2. The tenderers are advised to visit NIT Campus / site of work and get themselves acquainted with the site conditions, quantum and nature of works before submitting the offer.
- 3. Area of activities under this contract the quarter's list enclosed.
- 4. The successful tenderer is required to submit detailed program matching the above periodicity and as per Annexure before commencing the work so as to maintain clean and garbage free environment at any point of time.
- 5. All labour, consumables, tools & plants etc are under the scope of the contractor. Successful tenderer is required to maintain proper logbook for the consumption of materials and submit to the department for its approval.
- 6. Minimum wage as approved by CPWD is applicable for this contract for payment to all the labourers. ESI,EPF as applicable under labour laws.
- 7. Quoted rate is firm till the completion of the contract.
- 8. Successful tenderer shall ensure their working group wear uniform supplied by the contractor & carry identity card
- 9. The agency shall have to get the acknowledgement once in a weekly from the occupants for daily collection of garbage in the prescribed format which is a basis for making payment.
- 10. Necessary recovery shall be effected for non-compliance of the following work.
  - a. The agency is liable for penal action, in case of failure of work, the penalty will be imposed by considering the quantum of works omitted.
- 11. The contract Agreement should be signed within 10days of the providing of work order.
- 12. The outsourcing agency should report everyday about the no. of persons engaged by 7AM to Sanitary Inspector/EMD.
- 13. Termination of contract by giving one month notice from both side
- 14. Performance security 5% of Bank Guarantee.
