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

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| ITEM NO. 82.4 | RECRUITMENT FOR TEACHING VACANT POSITIONS | |
| | Our Institute had a sanctioned faculty strength of 393 based on student strength of academic year 2010-2011. Further Ministry of Education sanctioned an additional 212 teaching posts vide OM F.No.19-2/2024-TS.III dated 8th May 2025. The sanction of additional faculty post to our institute has been reported to Board in its 81 st meeting. Institute has a sanctioned faculty strength of 605 posts, with 360 filled (existing 358 & 2 yet to join) and 245 vacancies proposed for the recruitment, which includes 62 vacancies in the Assistant Professor (Grade II, Level 11) cadre. As per the CEI Act 2019 and Ministry's guidelines, the sanctioned strength means the number of posts in teachers' cadre approved by Board. Accordingly, it is resolved to fix the strength of teacher's cadre as follows: Professors (including HAG) – 141, Associate Professor – 77, Assistant Professor (Grade I) (Pay level 12) – 123, Assistant Professor (Grade II) (Pay level 11) – 112 and Assistant Professor (Grade I) (Pay level 10) – 152. | |

As per the MOE's guidelines, the Assistant Professor (Grade II, Level 11) posts are to be filled 'NOT through open advertisement' and for the departments that do not have any vacancy, movement in higher Academic Grade Pay or cadre shall be carried out as per the specified selection process, but it will be restricted to only serving faculty members of the respective departments.

For departments which are not having any vacancy at any higher Pay Level, movement to higher Pay Level shall be carried out as per prescribed selection process but it will be restricted to only serving faculty members of NIT, Trichy in the respective Department. [As prescribed in note 1, point no. 5 of Schedule 'E' of NIT Statutes (Amended 2017) (Ref. Gazette of India No. 651, dated July 24, 2017)]. Further, the Board authorized the Director to nominate suitable experts from among the IITs, NITs, SPAs and other Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) for the purpose of faculty recruitment.


The Board deliberated and considered for approval of the sanction strength of the faculty posts & to advertise the 122 vacant posts as proposed.

| | <p>Dr (Mrs) Priyanka, Medical officer was granted Extraordinary Leave (EOL) without pay, for a period of three years wef 27 Oct 2022 for pursuing higher studies (MD), as approved by Board in its 70th and 71st meetings. She executed the prescribed bond to serve the Institute for a period of three years upon completion of the EOL. She has now completed her MD programme and rejoined duty at the institute on 26 Oct 2025.</p> <p>As per para 4(ii) of DoPT OM No. 16/2/2009-Estt.(Pay-I) dated 12.09.2010, reiterated vide DoPT OM dated 12.09.2022 (copy placed at annexure), <i>“the EOL granted to a Government servant for prosecuting higher technical and scientific studies counts as qualifying service for pension and for increments.”</i></p> <p>However as per Institute Leave rule 3.8.5,</p> <p><i>“3.8.5 - The period of extra ordinary leave taken by an employee for illness on medical certificate will count for annual increments and qualifying service for terminal benefits as well. Extra ordinary Leave availed for all other purpose will not be counted for increment and terminal benefits; provided that in case of any doubt the decision of the Board shall be final.”</i></p> <p>The Board examined the matter in accordance with the DoPT norms and approved that the Extraordinary Leave (EOL) availed by the Medical Officer be treated as qualifying service for all service-related matters, including the grant of increment.</p> | |

After completion of 5 years of service as Security officer with GP 5400/- the concerned official was assessed by DPC and upgraded to higher GP of Rs 6600/-/ Pay level 11 with same designation wef 21.07.2023.</p> <p>In the Recruitment rules (RRs) 2017 the post of Security Officer has been abolished and it was recommended in the Recruitment rules (RRs) 2019, <i>“the existing Security officer may be allowed to continue and in due course re-trained for other suitable task.”</i></p> <p>The Board considered the proposal for re-designation of the post of Security Officer as Assistant Registrar. After detailed deliberations, the Board observed that RR 2019 does not stipulate to re-designate or convert the Security officer post into another cadre. The officials concerned will continue to receive financial benefits under MACP Scheme. The Board instructed to place the matter in the next meeting to re-examine the proposal in light of recent instructions.</p> | |



The FC was informed that the recruitment is under process for the 42 Direct Recruitment vacancies and 136 posts were vacant due to the promotional posts. The current vacancies are managed by engaging NMR, Apprentices and manpower through outsourcing agencies. The strength of all manpower (regular + contract + other sources) is currently maintained within the sanctioned strength, which is not adequate due to increase in the student and faculty strength. The Finance Committee suggested to forward the proposal along with the justification to the Ministry.</p> <p>Considering the acute shortage of manpower in handling the research laboratories and administrative offices, the deployment of additional 50 manpower through an outsource agency is proposed to cater the requirement of the Institute and to maintain the quality of outputs until the sanction of the additional Non-teaching posts.</p> <p>The Board deliberated the matter and considered for approval as recommended by Finance Committee.</p> |




