She shared the happy news that the Ministry of Education, GoI has appointed Shri. Bhaskar Bhat, Director, Tata Sons and Ex- Managing Director of Titan Company, as the Chairperson, Board of Governors, NIT, Tiruchirappalli. She congratulated the faculty members for their cooperation and constant effort towards the successful completion of the examination for UG and PG programmes.

She informed that NIT, Tiruchirappalli was part of the conclave organized by UGC & Ministry of Education on “Transformational Reforms in Higher Education” under National Education

Policy– 2020. The details of Equitable use of Technology for Better Reach in Education were presented and discussed in the forum. She mentioned that the Institute had celebrated 74th Independence day on 15th August 2020. 3. Results of UG and PG courses (other than Final Years) for the January session 2019-20

The Senate approved the results of UG and PG courses (other than Final Years) for the January session 2019-20 as approved by the respective Performance Analysis Committees (PACs).

The Senate was informed that the academic office had not received the results of II Semester courses of B. Tech. (CSE) (Section A & B) from the PAC Chairperson concerned. The Senate discussed the matter at length and directed the HoD concerned to take necessary action to publish the results in time. The Senate was also informed about the pending results of following courses namely

- 1. CSPC29 Introduction to Algorithms (B. Tech. (IV) / CSE / Section A)*
- 2. CS604 Advanced Databases (M. Tech. (CSE) / II Semester)*

3. AR306 Landscape Architecture (B. Arch. / VI Semester)

4. AR110 Building Construction and Materials-I (B. Arch. / II & IV Semester)

The Senate directed the Head of department of Computer Science and Engineering to take appropriate steps to publish the results immediately while the Head of department of Architecture to inform the faculty concerned to speed up the process to publish the results immediately.

4. Award of UG / PG / M. S. (by Research) and Ph. D. degrees in the 16th Convocation

The 16th Convocation of NIT, Tiruchirappalli is planned to be held through virtual mode in October 2020. As on 31st August 2020, a total of 805 UG, 729 PG, 18 M. S. (by Research) and 101 Ph. D. graduands are eligible to receive the degree during the convocation. Out of 767 B. Tech, 72 students receive B. Tech. (Honours) degree. The details of department-wise number of graduands, are presented in Table 1 while those of Honours and Minor graduands in Table 2 and Table 3 respectively.

6. Request from Department

To consider the request of HoD, Metallurgical and Materials Engineering to approve the sponsored programme elective course "MTPE27 Stainless steels and Advanced Ferrous Alloys" handled by experts from M/s Jindal Stainless Limited and retired IIT professors for students of B. Tech. (Metallurgical and Materials Engineering) in the

July 2020 session. The course has been passed by the Board of Studies of the Department concerned.

The senate opined that there should be some remuneration to the personnel/faculty handling the course, though the course is sponsored, from the institute and it was clarified that the industry that sponsors the course pays remuneration to the industry personnel and institute faculty.

The Senate approved the course titled "MTPE27 Stainless steels and Advanced Ferrous Alloys" for students of B. Tech. (Metallurgical and Materials Engineering) in the July 2020 session. Further, the Senate opined that based on demand from students in future this course can be offered as an open elective course instead of programme elective.

RESOLUTION **RESOLVED THAT** the course titled "MTPE27 Stainless steels and Advanced Ferrous Alloys" for students of B.Tech. (Metallurgical and Materials Engineering) in the July 2020 session was approved as a special case with the above mentioned observations of the Senate.

It was considered at the moment that for faculty in the department of Architecture, the essential qualification without insisting on credit point requirements at Assistant Professor level is M. Arch. / M. Plan. with one year and two years of experience at AGP 6000 and 7000 respectively and there are some regular employees who would like to pursue research in the institute. The following guideline has been discussed to encourage the internal faculty from the department of Architecture and regular

employees of the institute only to apply for PhD program:

The faculty members of department of Architecture and regular employees of NIT Tiruchirappalli, having cleared any national eligibility test at any point of time, will be permitted to apply for Ph. D. program with relaxation in experience.


