## **CIRCULAR**

In light of the Nipah virus outbreak in Kerala on 4<sup>th</sup> September 2023, certain precautionary measures are to be initiated on our campus. All students and institute fraternity are requested to kindly adhere to the following rules and precautions.

- 1. Any student/ employee with a history of travel to Kerala in the past 20 days, with symptoms of fever, headache, confusion, and cough should immediately isolate and report to NITT Hospital at 0431-2503860.
- 2. If the person was in contact with any patient with the aforementioned symptoms during his/her visit to Kerala, even if the person has no symptoms, should immediately notify to authorities at NITT Hospital.
- 3. Unnecessary travel to the affected areas is to be avoided until the situation is under control to prevent serious outbreaks.
- 4. Hostel authorities are requested to be vigilant in monitoring and recording the travel details of the students traveling to/from the Kozhikode district of Kerala
- 5. If students, faculty, employees, and family members have travelled to the Kozhikode district of Kerala recently, inform our hospital immediately.

All are requested to kindly follow these instructions strictly for the general health and safety of our institution.
